



*Note - The lot numbers from 1 to 1023 are those shown on the original development plan - As far as possible these numbers have been made to conform to the City plan and sales records - There are however in many places where Avenue locations have been materially changed, some discontinued altogether, and sections intended for Open spaces, playgrounds, etc. for sanitary purposes, that the old numbers now have little or no significance - In such places it has seemed better to indicate lots as now occupied without trying to superimpose lines of the old plan on the new - Numbers above 1023 are from more recent surveys and are given and conform to the sales records. ....*
